

**RESOLUTION GIVING PUBLIC NOTICE OF LARAMIE COUNTY'S INTENT TO AMEND THE 2002 LARAMIE COUNTY FIREWORKS REGULATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Wyoming State Statutes § 16-3-103; §18-5-201 to 18-5-208; §18-5-301 to 18-5-315 authorize Laramie County, in promoting the public health, safety, morals and general welfare of the county, to regulate the use of land through zoning in unincorporated Laramie County; and **WHEREAS**, WYO. STAT. ANN. § 16-3-103 (2007), requires 45 days public notice and a reasonable opportunity for public comment before Laramie County may adopt, amend, or repeal rules and regulations; and **WHEREAS**, The Laramie County Board of Commissioners adopted the Laramie County Fireworks Regulations on July 16th, 2002. **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF LARAMIE COUNTY, WYOMING**, that notice is hereby given to the public that Laramie County intends to adopt an amendment to the first sentence in Section III. FIREWORKS STAND AND SITE IMPROVEMENTS, C., to now read "Fireworks stands or storage units shall not be located closer than thirty (30) feet from the property boundaries." The current regulations say sixty (60) feet; that copies of the proposed regulation may be obtained from the Laramie County Clerk's Office, 309 West 20<sup>th</sup> Street, Room 1513, Cheyenne, Wyoming; that all interested persons may submit written comments to the Laramie County Clerk, 309 West 20<sup>th</sup> Street, P.O. Box 608, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82003, no later than noon on November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018; that there shall be a regularly scheduled Laramie County Planning Commission Meeting on November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2018 and a regularly scheduled Laramie County Commissioner's meeting on November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 3:30 P.M. in the Laramie County Commissioners hearing room on the third floor of the Laramie County Courthouse, 310 West 19<sup>th</sup> Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming; and that this notice shall be published once in the Wyoming Tribune-Eagle/Pine Bluffs as soon as practicably possible. **PRESENTED, READ AND ADOPTED** this 2nd day of October 2018.
