Ronald Sargent is currently the coroner for Laramie County, Wyoming. For the past nine years, Sargent has been a deputy Laramie County coroner and served as coroner upon the death of coroner Bill Ryan in 2006.

Sargent has served 25 years as a search and rescue diver for the Laramie County Underwater Search and Rescue. He also served nearly eight years as a Reserve Deputy for the Laramie County Sheriff's Office attaining the rank of Sgt. He was a special agent examiner for the Office of the Attorney General, Division of Criminal Investigations—Wyoming State Crime Laboratory as head of the identification team.

Sargent has instructed classes in crime-scene processing and photography at the Wyoming Law Enforcement Academy. He has been an award-winning adjunct instructor in the Criminal Justice Program for eight years at Laramie County Community College.
