

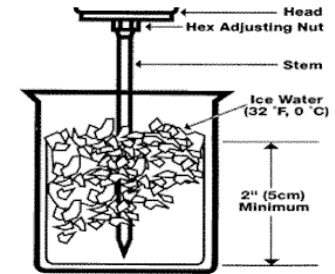


Thermometer Calibration Log

****Calibrate thermometers once a week and when dropped.****

How to Calibrate a Dial Thermometer:

1. Fill glass with ice (crushed ice is best) and add a little water.
2. Submerge thermometer stem so water level reaches metal indication on the stem.
3. Wait a minute for the temperature to adjust.
4. If the temperature does not read 32°F beside the ice use a small wrench on a dial thermometer to turn the nut behind the dial face until the thermometer reads 32°F. If you have a digital thermometer you may be able to send it to the manufacturer for recalibration.



Enter initials when thermometer is calibrated correctly.
