- 090827 00** The Laramie County Planning Commission met in regular session Thursday, August 27, 2009 at 3:30 p.m. Those in attendance were Commissioner Paula Qualls, Vice-Chairman; Commissioner Frank Cole; Commissioner Jim Ward; Commissioner Bert Macy and Recording Secretary Valerie Roybal.

Those also in attendance were Nancy Olson, MPO.

- 01** Vice-Chairman Paula Qualls introduced the item on the agenda and asked Abby Yenco to give her staff report. Senior Planner Abby Yenco stated that the item being brought before the Planning Commission will be the new procedures of how subdivision plats are being brought into the public hearing process. The new process will be on preliminary and final plats. The following is the order of the process: 1st: Introduced to the County Planning Commission; 2nd: The approval of the Board of County Commissioners who would also set the conditions; 3rd: The applicant would then go to the City Development Office, submit an application, have it under review and then wait for approval through the City Council. These rules were adopted on June 2, 2009. Vice-Chairman Qualls opened the public hearing. Hearing no public comment, Vice-Chairman Qualls closed the public hearing. Commissioner Cole moved to recommend adoption of the proposed changes to the subdivision regulations to the Board of County Commissioners with the addition that the City would concur with the County concerning road requirements. Commissioner Cole added that road development should be in conformance with the final road and street plan. The road patterns should match between the City and the County. Commissioner Ward seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
