Early voting sites for Primary Election set up in Albin, Iron Mountain; voting continues in Atrium through Aug. 15

The Laramie County Clerk's Office is setting up early voting sites in Albin and Iron Mountain for voters who wish to cast their ballots in advance of the state's August 16 Primary Election.

County Clerk Debra Lee said election teams will bring voting machines and materials to the outreach sites. Voters may vote at the Albin Community Center, 430 5th Ave., on Tues., Aug. 9, or at the Iron Mountain Country Church, 1971 Rd 109, on Weds., Aug. 10. Polls will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in both locations.

Early voting continues in the Atrium of the Laramie County Complex in Cheyenne through Aug. 15. The site is open to all Laramie County voters Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:45 p.m.

Laramie County residents age 18 and above who have not yet registered may register and vote at the sites in Cheyenne, Albin or Iron Mountain. Persons registering for the first time and those who registered by mail and are voting in their first federal election are required to present a government-issued photo ID, such as a Wyoming driving license.

"The early voting sites are convenient for those unable to come to a vote center on Aug. 16 or who want to avoid waiting in line on Election Day," said Lee.

Lee said voters may request to have an absentee ballot mailed by calling the clerk's office at (307) 633-4242 or emailing tory@laramiecountyclerk.com. You will be asked to provide your name as it appears on the voter registration roll, your date of birth, and residential address.
