#### **Primary Election candidate filing period starts May 17, ends June 1**

The 2018 election season officially kicks off at 8:00 a.m., Thursday, May 17, with the start of candidate filing for the Aug. 21 Primary Election. The Laramie County Clerk's office will accept candidate applications for county offices including commissioner, assessor, treasurer, clerk, coroner, sheriff, clerk of district court, and district attorney.

Applications may be filed in person May 17 through June 1, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., at the election office or mailed to Laramie County Clerk, Elections, 309 W 20<sup>th</sup> St., Cheyenne, WY 82001. Applications must be received no later than close of business on June 1, the last day for filing.

The candidate application form is available at the Clerk's office and is posted on the election page of the clerk's website at <http://www.laramiecountyclerk.com/elections.aspx>.

County Clerk Debra Lee said the list of candidates who have filed will be updated on the website by 5:30 p.m., Monday-Friday, during the filing period.

Lee noted candidates for state offices file with the Wyoming Secretary of State, while those running for city council file with the city clerk.
