### **Laramie County Clerk, Phi Theta Kappa & League of Women Voters to conduct voter outreach at LCCC on Tuesday**

CHEYENNE –Students, faculty and others interested in the upcoming election will have the opportunity to register and ask questions about voting during an outreach event at Laramie County Community College on Tuesday, Oct. 16. The event takes place at the LCCC Community Center student lounge from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

The County Clerk's office, in partnership with the LCCC chapter of Phi Theta Kappa and the Cheyenne League of Women Voters is sponsoring the event. The outreach event coincides with two youth workshops, sponsored by the Secretary of State's office, as part of the Wyoming Youth Voter Initiative.

The Cheyenne League of Women Voters will have materials about being informed and getting involved and will have "I Registered!" pins for everyone who uses the opportunity to register to vote.

LWV is a nonpartisan group that promotes participation of people in their government.

Qualifications for registration and voting are U.S. citizenship, Laramie County residency, age 18 or older by Election Day, and voting rights restored if convicted of a felony. Registrants must present a valid, government-issued identity document, such as a Wyoming driving license, U.S. passport or student ID. Persons unable to attend the outreach event can still register and vote at the Laramie County Governmental Complex, 309 W 20<sup>th</sup> St., until Nov. 5, or at a vote center on General Election Day, Nov. 6.
