The second voter event takes place in Burns at the Burns Plex Community Center, 327 S Main, on Tuesday, July 17, from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Residents who are eligible to register to vote are requested to bring a valid government-issued identification document (Wyoming driving license preferred). Eligibility requirements for registration are U.S. citizenship, Laramie County resident, at least 18 years of age by the date of the election, and if convicted of a felony, voting rights must have been restored.
