Primary Election candidate filing period starts May 14, ends May 29

The 2020 election season officially kicks off at 8:00 a.m., Thursday, May 14, with the start of candidate filing for the Aug. 18 Primary Election. The Laramie County Clerk's office will accept applications for county commissioner and party precinct people.

For the first time, candidates may send applications via email office@laramiecountyclerk.com or fax 307-633-4240. Applications are on the Laramie County Clerk's election page at <https://elections.laramiecountyclerk.com/candidates-corner/> and are available at the Clerk's office in the Laramie County Governmental Complex, 309 W 20th St. Candidates may also mail their applications or file in-person from May 14-19, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., in the election office. Applications and filing fee must be received no later than close of business on May 29, the last day for filing. County commissioner applicants may pay the filing fee by credit card or check.

County Clerk Debra Lee said the list of candidates who have filed will be updated on the website by 5:30 p.m., Monday-Friday, during the filing period.

Lee noted candidates for state offices file with the Wyoming Secretary of State, while those running for city offices file with the city clerk.
